
Why promote a responsible agriculture and food sector?

Highly vulnerable to climate change





Client Protection Standards for the Agricultural Sector









2/ Agri CP Tool - Purpose



Avoid bad practices from agribusinesses that cause harm to smallholder farmers

"Client" = "smallholder farmers"

Be they clients or suppliers of agribusinesses

➤ Focus on agribusinesses that work with smallholder farmers

2/ Agri CP Tool - Structure

- THE PROVIDER'S PRODUCTS, SERVICES, AND CHANNELS BENEFIT CLIENTS.
- THE PROVIDER DOES NOT OVERINDEBT CLIENTS.
- THE PROVIDER GIVES CLIENTS CLEAR AND TIMELY INFORMATION TO SUPPORT CLIENT DECISION MAKING.
- THE PROVIDER SETS PRICES RESPONSIBLY.
- THE PROVIDER ENFORCES FAIR AND RESPECTFUL TREATMENT OF CLIENTS.
- THE PROVIDER SECURES CLIENT DATA AND INFORMS
- THE PROVIDER RECEIVES AND RESOLVES CLIENT COMPLAINTS.
- THE GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT ARE COMMITTED TO CLIENT PROTECTION, AND HR SYSTEMS SUPPORT ITS IMPLEMENTATION.

Aligned with the 8 client protection standards used in the financial inclusion sector

Adapted to the specificities of the agriculture sector

Standard	1	The organization's products, services, and channels benefit smallholder farmers.
Standard	2	The organization does not overindebt smallholder farmers.
Standard	3	The organization gives smallholder farmers clear and timely information to support farmers' decision making.
Standard	4	The organization sets prices responsibly.
Standard	5	The organization enforces fair and respectful treatment of smallholder farmers.
Standard	6	The organization secures smallholder farmer data and informs them about their data rights.
Standard	7	The organization receives and resolves complaints related to its own operations, employees, agents, products and services from the following stakeholders: smallholder farmers / local communities / other affected stakeholders.
Standard	8	The governance and management are committed to smallholder farmer protection, and HR systems support its implementation

2/ Agri CP Tool - Scoping

The Agri CP Tool allows for filtering in and out indicators based on the types of services provided to / types of interactions with smallholders farmers:

Integrating standards on...

- Aggressive sales
- Transparency on T&Cs and pricing
- Fair and respectful treatment
- Privacy of client data
- Overdependence on service providers

Where we stand today







Survey conducted with SNUPP partners (investors): 75% see an interest to use the RAI Tool as a reference tool to assess agribusinesses in the sector.























Still at an early stage...

- Need to fine-tune the added-value and positioning of these tools,
- Confront them with real-life situations,
- Adjust them based on the sector needs,
- Align on a common language,
- Create a supportive environment to promote their use and support improvement of practices.



What comes now

A two-year project to equip stakeholders with management tools and audit resources that integrate responsible business conduct and client protection standards.



The RAF Project in a nutshell

1/ POSITIONNING AND TESTING OF EXISTING TOOLS

- Tool and standards mapping
- Industry meetings
- Working group creation
- Field tests of existing tools (1-2 per tool)
- Positioning analysis

2/ DEVELOPMENT AND TESTING OF RAF TOOLS

- Development of a suite of RAF tools (RAF Full, RAF CP, RAF "ALINUS"), involving Working Group members
- Training of 6-8 auditors
- Field tests of RAF tools with at least 8 agribusinesses
- Feedback analysis

3/ STABILIZATION AND PROMOTION OF RAF TOOLS

- Fine-tuning of RAF tools
- Translation into FR and ES
- Official launch of the RAF tools + audit guide + case studies

- Resource Center material
- Training and e-learning course
