Appendix C of the Environmental Policy Template for Financial Service Providers (FSPs)

This appendix provides a **template implementation plan** for translating the environmental policy into a **tracking table** (objectives by type and specific, target, activities, budget, responsible parties, and timeline) with **examples** of pre-filled objectives. This appendix helps FSPs **prioritize**, budget, and **manage** their commitments in a measurable way by establishing a clear planning-execution-monitoring cycle. To use it: first select the priority objectives of your environmental policy, **complete each line** (results, activities, budget, person responsible) by **working as a team**, distribute the actions over the years in the table, monitor progress in committee (updating it regularly) and adjust the plan based on audits and feedback from the field.
